Home Base: Historical Museum, 10 River St E

The Prince Albert Historical Society has partnered with five local homeowners to open their houses to the public to highlight some of the earlier homes in Prince Albert. Each home dates to Prince Albert's boom period of 1912. The homes will be open to ticket holders from 1pm to 5pm on Sunday, October 27th.

Tickets will be sold at the Historical Museum: \$25 in advance and \$30 the day of the event. Only 100 tickets will be printed. Each ticket holder will be entered into a draw for a one night stay for two at the Red Pine Bed and Breakfast!

On the day of the tour, the Historical Museum will be the visitor home base, providing information, washrooms, and light refreshments. Ticket holders are responsible for their own transportation to the homes. Volunteers will be on hand at each house to guide ticket holders through the house.

This tour will help raise funds to reconstruct the Nisbet Church and Blockhouse on the riverbank west of the Historical Museum.
